1. BACKGROUND:

The Securities and Exchange Board of India ("SEBI"), vide its Notification dated September 2, 2015, has issued the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ("Regulations"). The Regulations come into force from December 1, 2015. The Regulations mandate listed entities to formulate an archival policy. It is in this context that the Policy on Archival of Documents ("Policy") is being framed and implemented.

2. OBJECTIVE OF THE POLICY:

The objective of this Policy is to comply with Regulation 30(8) of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as mentioned below:

"The listed entity shall disclose on its website all such events or information which has been disclosed to stock exchange(s) under this regulation, and such disclosures shall be hosted on the website of the listed entity for a minimum period of five years and thereafter as per the archival policy of the listed entity, as disclosed on its website."

3. DEFINITIONS:

- I. Board" means the Board of Directors of Baron Infotech Limited
- II. "Company" means Baron Infotech Limited
- III. "Policy" means this Policy, as amended from time to time
- IV. "Listing Regulations" means the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (including any amendments thereof).

4. ARCHIVAL POLICY:

The Company shall disclose on its website all such events or information which has been disclosed to stock exchange(s) under Regulation 30 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, and such disclosures shall be hosted on the website of the listed entity for a minimum period of five years and thereafter as per the archival policy of the Company, as disclosed on its website.

5. AMENDMENTS:

The Board shall have the power to amend any of the provisions of this Policy, substitute any of the provisions with a new provision or replace this Policy entirely with a new Policy.
